



MARY FLYNN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP 2008 – 2009 GUIDELINES

1. The applicant shall be a member of the Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary or a dependent of a living or deceased Disabled American Veteran or a Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary member of North Carolina.
2. Application forms shall be furnished by the Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary State Adjutant and shall be sent upon written request.
3. The completed application packet should contain: (1) a student application, (2) four letters of recommendation, one of which should be from the candidate's minister, school guidance counselor, teacher or employer and (3) a letter of acceptance from the college/university the applicant will attend.
4. Applications and recommendations should reflect the applicant's contributions in academic, civic, social and related school areas.
5. A Grade Point Average of 2.5 is required.
6. Completed applications shall be sent to the DAV Auxiliary State Adjutant (see address below), postmarked on or before May 1 of the current year.
7. The application shall be reviewed by the members of the DAV Auxiliary Mary Flynn Memorial Scholarship Committee. Candidates will be interviewed at the discretion of the committee.
8. All applications must be kept on file for a full year, May 1 to May 1, of the following year.
9. The committee shall determine the number of scholarships and the amount of scholarships based on funds available. Only one award will be made per academic year per recipient and shall be paid directly to the college/university. The scholarship must be used for the upcoming academic year.
10. Renewal for the Mary Flynn Memorial Scholarship is not automatic - applicants must reapply each year and continue to meet the criteria set by the committee.
11. The Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary Mary Flynn Memorial Scholarship Committee shall notify the successful candidate (s) and inform the other candidate (s) as soon as the scholarship recipient (s) is/are selected.
12. All applications and information concerning applications will be held in strict confidence.
